



Driveway and Landscape Design

Approval Procedures

A Driveway/Walkway Design Plan and a Landscape Design Plan are to be submitted to the ACC after all exterior finishes have been installed and painted as approved. The plans should be submitted on an approved site plan indicating the final location of the drive and each walkway, and the initial landscape design. Both the Driveway/Walkway Design Plan and the Landscape Design Plan can be submitted on the same site plan.

Driveway and Walkway Plan

Driveways must be asphalt material and walkways must be of natural stone or approved brick pavers. Please reference pages 13 and 14 of the Residential Design Guidelines and Restrictions for additional information.

Landscape Plan

A landscape plan is to be submitted simultaneously with the driveway/walkway plan and must include the number of replacement trees requested by the ACC, along with tree species and all other shrub and plant species as intended. Please reference pages 24 through 27, Section 6, of the Residential Design Guidelines and Restrictions for additional information.

The Recommended Plant Selection Guide lists shrubs, trees and ferns that grow well in this environment.
